

District Protocols for Addressing Severe Peanut and Tree Nut Allergies

Indian Hill

Due to the age of the children in this building; this building is entirely peanut and tree nut free. No peanut or tree nut products are to ever be brought into the building.

Chippewa

In this building there are designated peanut and tree nut free classrooms and peanut and tree nut free zones (tables) in the lunchroom. Due to the age and maturity of the students in **1st grade** if their classroom is designated peanut and tree nut free, then all of the students in those classrooms should not be bringing peanut or tree nut products to school for snack or lunch. If a classroom is not designated peanut or tree nut free, there are no restrictions for what those students may bring for snack or lunch. In **2nd and 3rd grade** if they are in a peanut and tree nut free classroom, the student may not bring peanut or tree nut products for snack, but they may bring peanut or tree nut products for lunch. In the lunchroom there are designated tables that are peanut and tree nut free.

For clarification – 1st grade – peanut and tree nut free classroom = no peanut or tree nut products for snack or lunch

For 2nd and 3rd grade – peanut and tree nut free classroom = no peanut and tree nut products for snack, but can bring peanut and tree nut products for lunch where there are peanut free zones (tables)

For the 2015-2016 school year, 1st grade classrooms that are peanut and nut free include Mrs. Smuksta and Mrs. Klucharik (Plecki sub); 2nd grade classroom that is peanut and nut free include Ms. Agema; 3rd grade classroom that is peanut and nut free is Mrs. Sullivan.

Navajo Heights

In this building there are designated peanut and tree nut free classrooms and peanut and tree nut free zones (tables) in the lunchroom. Students in the peanut and tree nut free classrooms may not bring peanut or tree nut products for snack, but they may bring peanut or tree nut products for lunch. If a classroom is not designated peanut or tree nut free, there are no restrictions for what those students may bring for snack or lunch. In the lunchroom there are designated tables that are peanut and tree nut free.

For clarification – 4th and 5th grades – peanut and tree nut free classroom = no peanut or tree nut products for snack but can bring peanut and tree nut products for lunch where there are peanut free zones (tables)

For the 2015 -2016 school year, there are no peanut and tree nut free classrooms in 4th grade. In 5th grade the classroom that is peanut and tree nut free is Mrs. Weiss.

Independence

There are no restrictions, but there are peanut and tree nut free tables available in the lunchroom.
