- Begins to use simple tools and equipment for investigation.
- Makes comparisons among objects.

Four Year Olds

Scientific Thinking

- Asks questions and uses senses to observe, categorize, and explore materials and natural phenomena.
- Uses simple tools and equipment for investigation including computers.
- Makes comparisons among objects.
- Collects, describes, and records information.
- Describes the effects of forces in nature and uses weather-related vocabulary.
- Identifies basic concepts associated with time/sequence and seasons.
